

# Eduroam Instructions using Android:

On this page you learn how to access the University of Kassel Wi-Fi "eduroam" using Android.

## Requirements

- An activated UniAccount
- A smart phone with an Android version of at least 2.3.3.

The following instructions are based on Android 4.2.2. For Android 2 & 3 systems there are no major changes, and so these instructions can be used for earlier Android versions.

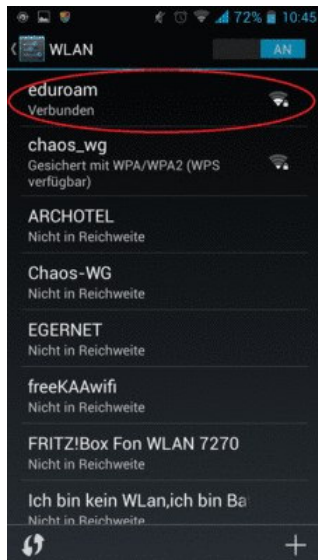
## Registration on Wi-Fi "eduroam"



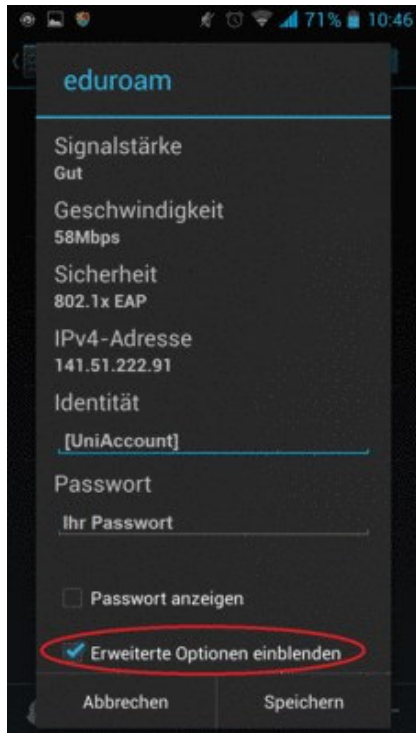
Open the menu in Android for *Einstellungen/Settings*.



In the Settings now select "*Wi-Fi*".



A window now opens with a list of available wireless networks. Select "eduroam", and the *Einstellungen/Settings* for "eduroam" open.



To be identified by the network as a user and to be able to register, you must enter the following:

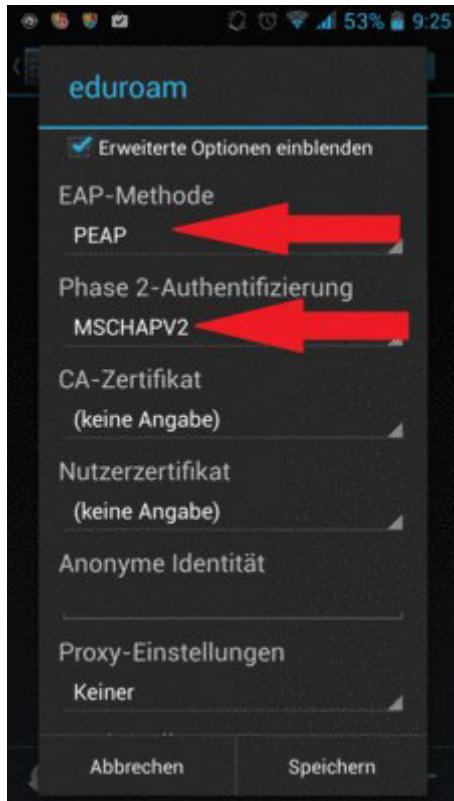
Identity: Your **UniAccount user name**

Password: Your **UniAccount password**

**Note:**

To avoid possible entry errors with the password, tick *Passwort anzeigen/Show password* and it will be displayed in letters and not the usual asterisks or dots.

Tick *Erweiterte Optionen anzeigen/Show additional options* to be able to create additional settings.



Now you should see the actual settings. To obtain access to Wi-Fi "eduroam" it is important to create the following settings:

*EAP-Methode/EAP Method: **PEAP***

*Phase 2 Authentifizierung/Authentication: **MSCHAPV2***

At the end save the settings and connect with "eduroam".
